CONTINUED CONTACT

PDC understands that community outreach is vital both during the permitting process, as well as prior to and during operations. PDC has notified thousands of stakeholders during the CAP permitting process including:

- All owners of minerals that would be developed under the CAP,
- All surface owners of the proposed locations and within the CAP Boundary*,
- All RBU owners within 2,000 ft of the proposed oil and gas locations,
- All local governments within the CAP boundaries,
- All proximate local governments,
- Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment,
- Colorado Parks and Wildlife,
- Colorado State Land Board,
- Bureau of Land Management,
- All high occupancy building units within the CAP boundaries,
- All childcare centers within the CAP boundaries,
- All school governing bodies within the CAP boundaries
